Edukey Annual Progress Report

Appreciation

This an annual progressive report for the projects implemented by Edukey with support from well-wishers and friends from the world. Appreciations go to Mr. Muganda Peter, the volunteer staffs and friends of the Edukey for supporting and offering their time for keeping on with the fire burning and lifting the motto high. The year ending and in review was challenged with the COVID 19 pandemic which affected people worldwide. Edukey just like other organisations, Institutions and communities was affected by the pandemic that led to the non-realisation of the planned program activities and projects. The total country lock down could not allow the implementation of the planned activities since there were no movements of staffs and beneficiaries to access the centre for the services.

Cultural dance and drama

When the total lockdown was lifted a bit and allowed movements of people on foot to do the exercise as one of the ways of fighting COVID 19 on addition to SOPs. Given the half lockdown lift, Edukey took advantage to conduct trainings in cultural dance and drama among the children while observing the SOPs at the centre. The trainings were done two days in weekly. Due to the limitations and observation of the social distancing by the Government 12 children were allowed during the training. The organization managed to conduct the trainings during the ending in a scientific way as per the operation standard procedures.

Computer training lesson

Since Computer literacy is important during this modern time, Edukey found it necessary to impart this skill into the young generation in the community. Since the children were not attending school due to the lockdown the organization took this opportunity to train them in computer literacy. With limited computers and observing the SOPs children were being trained in shifts. Over 45 children registered for the training where each shift could attract 20 trainees. The trainings were conducted for three days in a week for three hours.



Internship program

For the first time Edukey hosted an internship student from a University in Netherlands by the names of Nathan N.J. M Polaseke. Nathan applied to the organization to have his internship with Edukey for two months. He did his internship with Edukey for a period of two months. The internee was assigned some duties to work while at Edukey as below:-

Computer training in Excel

Nathan took part in computer literacy training at Edukey. He trained the children and youth in Excel package which they did not know. He took them in this package during the time he was with Edukey. A total of 35 children and youth benefited from Nathans computer training in Excel which they now cherish of it.

Education talk

Nathan was also assigned to conduct talks with the young people at Edukey. He was tusked to organize a talk about the right to education of children with comparison between Europe and Uganda. The objectives of this education talk were:-

- 1. To help the Ugandan children understand the system of education in Holland (Europe) compared to Uganda.
- 2. Help Uganda children understand the importance of education
- 3. Offer advice to the children about how they can perform and excel in their education

- Importance of education to parents and children
- Give advice to children on how they keep in school and complete their studies

Fortunately the request was positive whereby the mother contacted Start het nieuwe schooljaar which offered 25 Laptops to Edukey.
